

#### What We Learned

- Housing affordability challenges
- Limited "places to go" on-foot
- Lack of public transportation options and an overwhelmed system
- Pollution of Alewife Brook
- Some vacant and underutilized properties, resulting in 'inactive' streets
- Unsafe intersection at the Broadway/Warren fork

### **Opportunities**

- Establishing East Arlington as a "Complete Neighborhood"
- Emphasizing accessible
  connections to old/new open
  spaces; between civic functions
- Fostering Transit-OrientedCommunities
- Creating space for a mix of small-scale and medium-scale commercial activities
- Identifying sites for future (affordable) housing development

#### Affordable Arlington - Broadway for All Budgets!

- Diversify Housing Supply
  - Increase Housing Density at Arlington Housing Authority Site + East Arlington Gateway
- Lower Commuting Costs
  - Improve Pedestrian Walkability and Bicyclist Accessibility on the Broadway Corridor
  - Walkability on School-to-School Network
- *Increase* Public (i.e. **Free**!) Amenities
  - Public Library branch and open space at Warren Fork
  - Activate Alewife Greenway Bike Path to create an attractive outdoor space
  - Public Realm Programming along School-to-School Network






